

CLUE JUNIOR



Ages 5 and up

For 2 to 6 Players

It's the case of the broken toy in this "whodunit" game for kids. In this Clue Junior game, players are on a mission to discover which toy was broken, who broke it, and what time it was broken. Players roll the die to see if they can move their character, look under other character pawns, or peek under furniture tokens for clues. Kids can play detective, marking the detective notepad as they find clues, eliminate choices, and eventually solve the mystery. The game features classic Clue characters: Miss Scarlett, Col. Mustard, Mr. Green, Mrs. Peacock, Prof. Plum, and Dr. Orchid. Time for an accusation? Go for it! A correct accusation wins the game.

It's the case of the missing cake in this classic 'whodunnit' game for children. In the Cluedo Junior game, players are on a mission to discover who took a piece of cake, when they took it and what they drank with it. As players find clues, they eliminate choices and eventually discover what happened.

Players aim to solve the mystery of the missing cake to win the Cluedo Junior game. Who took a piece of the cake before dinner? When was it taken? What did they drink with it? Players roll the die to see if they can move characters, then they look under the characters and under the furniture on the board for clues that were placed in the beginning of the game. As the clues are gathered, choices are eliminated one by one until the actual culprit, time and drink are discovered.

The Cluedo Junior game has the classic 'whodunnit' gameplay, but is for children as young as 5 years old. As players find clues, they'll eliminate choices and eventually discover what happened. The game includes iconic Cluedo characters such as Miss Scarlett, Mrs Peacock, Col Mustard, Mr Green and Prof. Plum, and also features Dr Orchid, a genius biologist with a sweet tooth.

Children can take on the role of detective as they try to solve the mystery of the missing cake. Clues are uncovered throughout the game and by process of elimination players can hone in on suspects. The goal is to work out who took the cake, when it was taken and what the person drank along with the cake. The sleuth who works out all three wins the game.

Includes: gameboard, 6 character pieces, 6 furniture tokens, 7 white bases, 7 yellow bases, detective notepad, die, label sheet and game guide.
